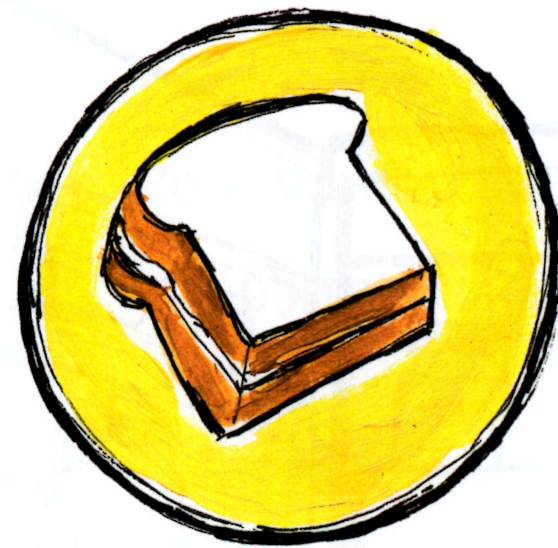

Pete is ready to eat.



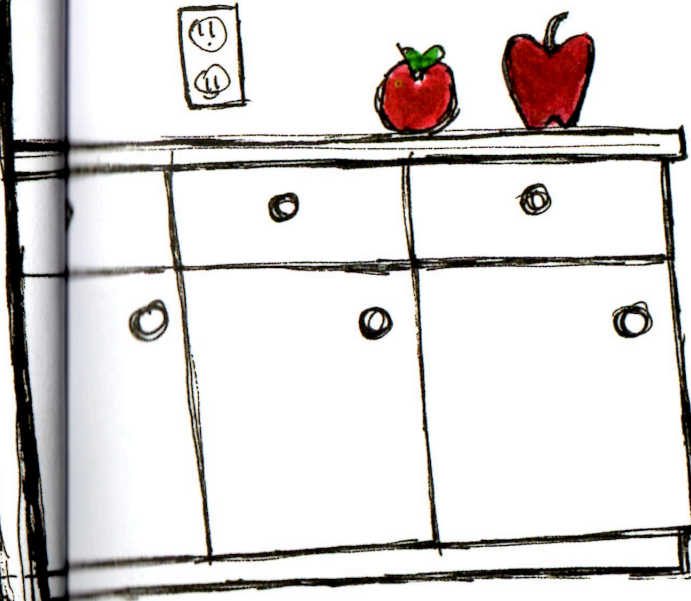
What should Pete eat?



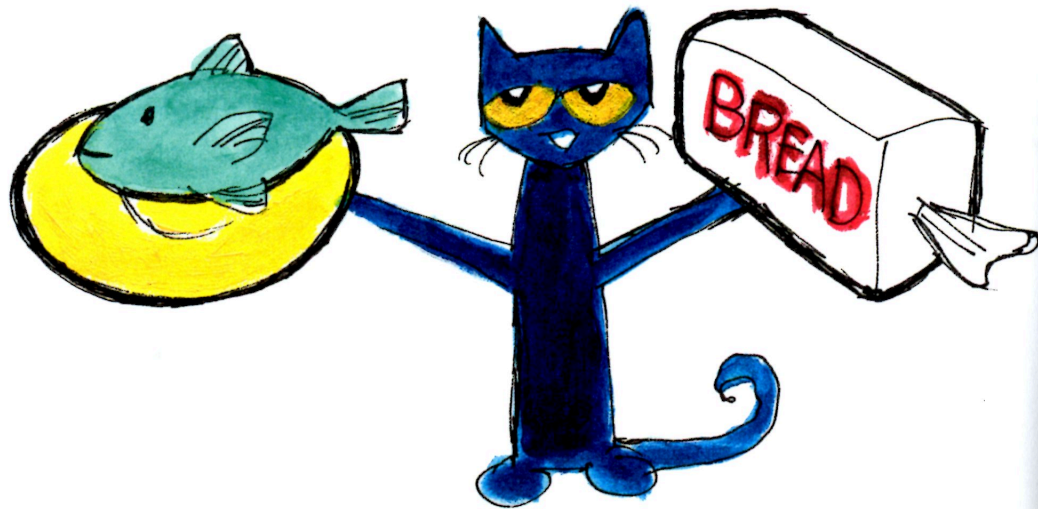
A sandwich would be nice.

Pete opens the fridge.



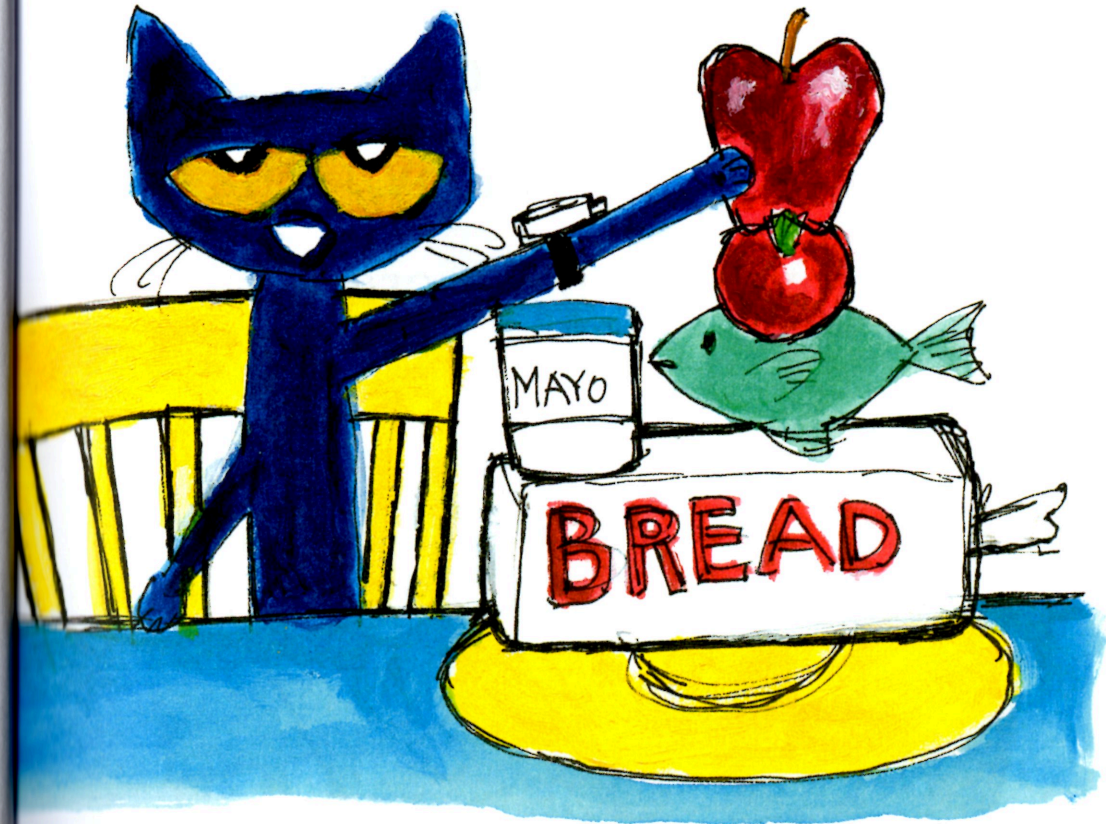
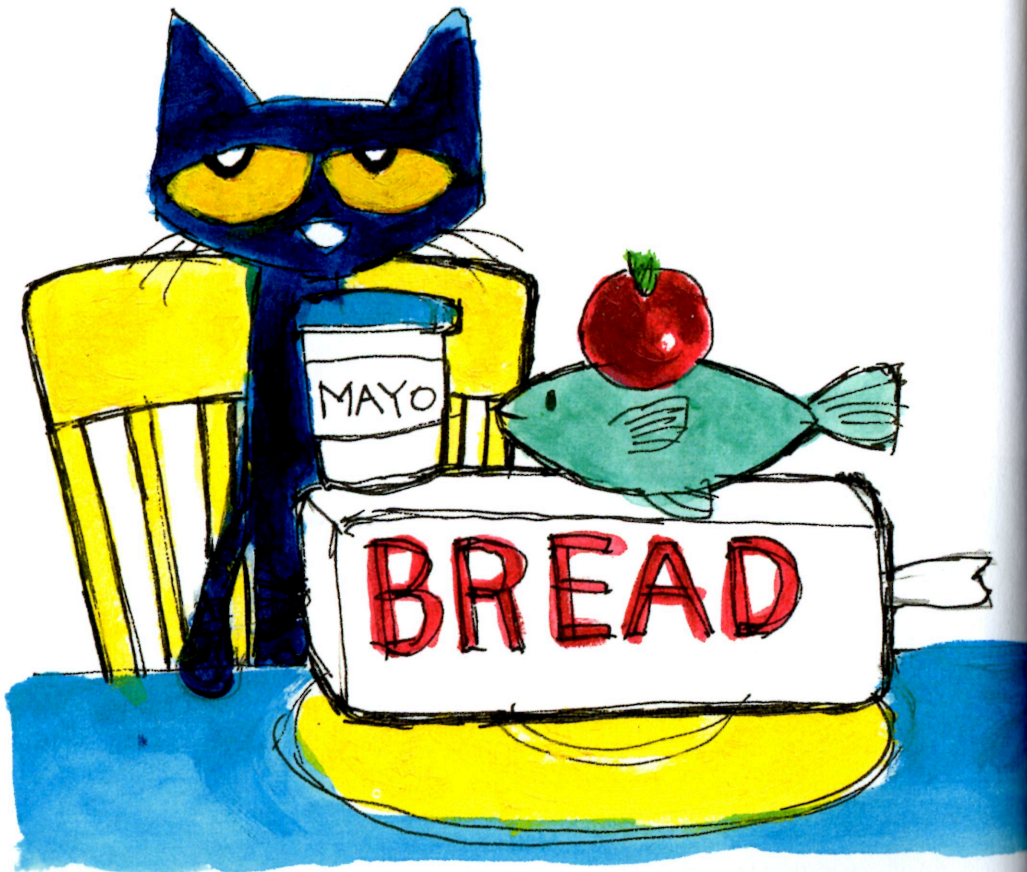

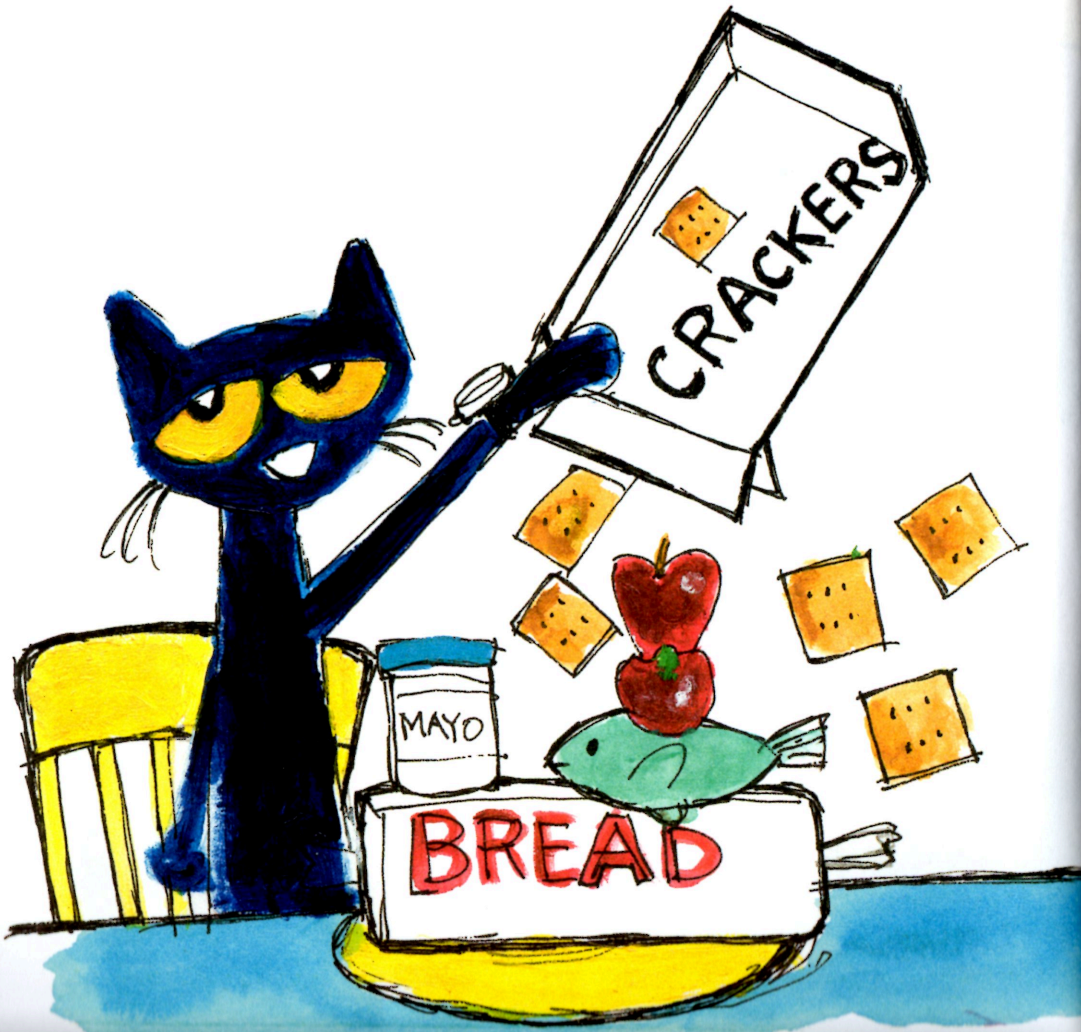


Pete looks at his sandwich.

It is still too small.



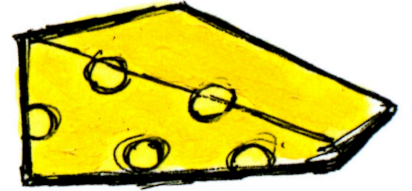
